- "ARCOS" refers to the Automation of Reports and Consolidated Orders System operated by DEA.
- "CSR" refers to Florida's state analogue to ARCOS, the Controlled Substance Reporting system.

   "Electronic-Florida Online Reporting of Controlled Substances
   Evaluation", aka the "Prescription Drug Monitoring Program" or

Distributing a device in or into Florida does not require licensure. PN Medical is a distributor of medical devices that DO NOT contain drugs, so does not require this business license.



• What is a "drug", "device", or "cosmetic"?

Also, "devices" that contain "drugs" are classified as drugs if any of the principal intended purposes is achieved through chemical action.

• What is "distributing"?

Understanding this term is critical to avoid violating Chapter 499, Florida Statutes. Florida law defines "distributing" or "distribution" to implicate both physical possession and legal title or ownership. The term means drug-donationprogram/)
